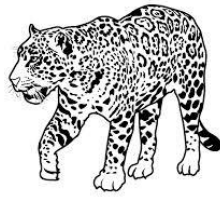

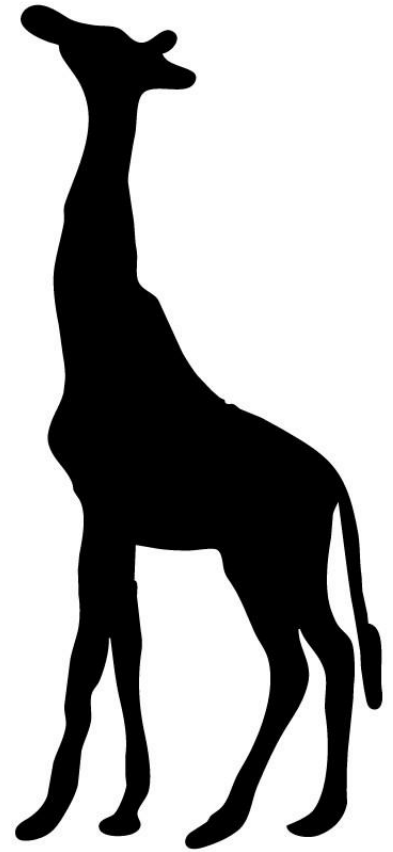

EXPRESS PAY



The Mater Dei Catholic High School Mothers & Friends Club is pleased to again offer the *Express Pay* option for this year's auction. This option will allow a guest to *Express Pay* via MasterCard or Visa upon arrival and avoid visiting the Bank at the conclusion of the auction.

To initiate Express Pay, present your MasterCard or Visa to the Bank prior to 6:30 PM.

We will imprint the card and request your signature on the credit card receipt. The bank is located in the administration office across from the cafeteria.

As the winning bids are determined and recorded throughout the evening, the bank runners will deliver a copy of the bid sheet to the successful bidder's table.

For guests using *Express Pay*, the bid sheet will be stamped "EXPRESS PAY" and will serve as your paid receipt for item pick up.

Your credit card receipt and guest statement will be mailed to you within one week of the auction. If you make no auction purchases, your credit card receipt will be destroyed.



REGULAR CHECK OUT



If you did not choose the *Express Pay* option, please follow the procedure below for paying for your purchases:

When the Bank re-opens at 9:30 PM or any time after the auction ends, go to the bank, located in the administration office across from the cafeteria.

Review your summary sheet and proceed with checkout. You may pay for your items with cash, check, Visa or MasterCard.

You may then pick up your items with your summary sheet stamped as "PAID". Items will not be released without presentation of a stamped "PAID" summary sheet.

***PLEASE NOTE THE BANK WILL CLOSE AT 6:30 PM AND REOPEN AT 9:30 PM TO ALLOW BANK WORKERS TO PROCESS BIDS.
NO CHECKOUTS WILL BE ALLOWED DURING THIS TIME.***

Tax Disclosure Statement

Beginning January 1, 1994, under new Section 6115 of the Internal Revenue Code, a charitable organization must provide a written document disclosure statement to donors who make a payment described as “quid pro quo contribution”, in excess of \$75.00. A “quid pro quo” contribution is payment made partly as a contribution and partly for goods or services provided to the donor by the charity. An example of a quid pro quo contribution is where the donor gives a charity \$100 in consideration for a concert ticket valued at \$40. In this example, \$60 would be deductible. Because the donor’s payment exceeds \$75, the disclosure statement must be furnished, even though the deductible amount does not exceed \$75. The required written statement must:

1. Inform the donor of the amount of the contribution that is deductible for federal income tax purposes, which is limited to the excess of any money contributed by the donor over the value of the goods and services provided by the charity.
2. Provide the donor with a good-faith estimate of the value of the goods or services that the donor received.

The disclosure must be in writing and must be made in a manner that is reasonably likely to come to the attention of the donor.

A penalty is imposed on charities that do not meet the disclosure requirements.

Please note that the prevailing basic rule allowing donor deductions, only to the extent that the payment exceeds the fair market value of the goods or services received in return, still applies generally to all quid pro quo contributions. The \$75 threshold pertains only to the obligations to disclose, not the rule on deductibility of the payment.

Please note that your initial statement this evening will include an itemized listing of all items purchased at the auction. This paid invoice can act as your receipt of acknowledgement of the amount bid for each item. For each individual item you will also receive an item listing which will include a “donor value” in which the auction committee and donors have made a “good faith” estimate of the item’s fair market value. Please use this information as your means of disclosure.

The committee has given considerable care to the publication of this catalog. We regret any errors or omissions.

Silent Auction



Silent Auction Rules

1. All items in the Silent Auction have bid sheets with corresponding numbers and names of items on the table. To make a bid, find the bid sheet with the name and number of the item wanted, then record your name and bid number. **Any bidder not stating his/her name AND bid number is disqualified for that bid.**
2. Each bid must start with the minimum bid, and depending upon the potential value of the item, the bid increments are preprinted for you on the bid sheet.

3. The Silent Auction Tables open for bidding at 5:15 PM with three separate closings based on the color of the items' table covers.

First Closing 6:30	Orange Tiger Tablecloths
Second Closing 7:00	Zebra Tablecloths
Third Closing 8:00	Green Bamboo Tablecloths

4. You may bid on any Silent Auction item until the section closes. Bidding for items in each section will close promptly at the times posted.
5. Scratching of bids is not allowed. Once a bid has been properly entered, it is a valid and binding bid.
6. A Mater Dei Auction chairperson may disqualify the bid of any person who attempts to block the way of others who wish to bid on the same item or items adjacent to it. If a bid is disqualified, the preceding bid will be honored. Only a Mater Dei Auction chairperson may nullify the bid.
7. In the event of a dispute, a Mater Dei Auction chairperson shall determine the winning bid. The decision is final.
8. The Auction Committee has attempted to catalog and describe the items and services correctly, but everything is sold "AS IS". Certain auction items and/or services may have restrictive use or other qualifications, which may affect value. Purchasers are bound by the precise restrictions specified by the donors. The items are non-negotiable. Please read the specifications and limitations carefully.
9. Values of the Silent Auction items are the donors' estimates and not warranted by the Auction Committee for tax purposes or for general value.
10. After the Silent Auction closing a runner will deliver one (1) copy of the contract to the successful bidder at his/her table.
11. Payment by the successful bidder may be made immediately or at the end of the auction at the Bank. If you have opted for Express Pay your Silent Auction items will be included in your express checkout. Please present your copies of the bid sheet(s) at the Bank. **PAYMENT IN FULL THE EVENING OF THE AUCTION IS MANDATORY.** The Bank will stamp your copies of the statement "PAID" and they will serve as your receipt. Show your copy of the "PAID" statement to the auction representative when you pick up your item. **ALL SALES ARE FINAL.** There will be no exchanges or refunds.
12. Items may be taken only by exhibiting a "PAID" receipt. The Auction Committee reserves the right to request that you display a "PAID" receipt at the time of departure. Please do not pick up Silent Auction items until the final closing of the night.

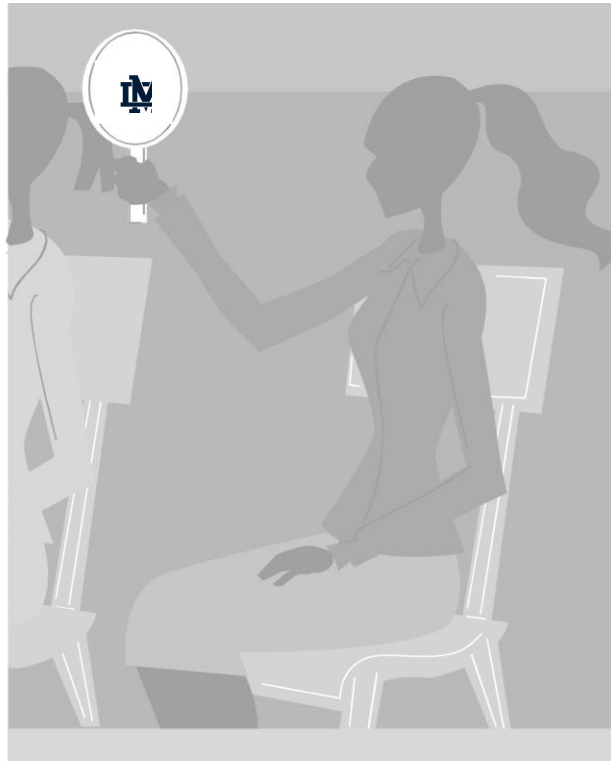
