



On behalf of the students, faculty, and administration I would like to thank you for willingly giving of your time, talent, and financial support to our school. Mater Dei exists today because you are concerned, caring, and devoted, and know the importance of carrying on the mission of the Church through Catholic education.

In this annual report are listed the names of those who donated to the 2014-2015 Annual Fund Drive. I sincerely thank those donors, without whom our efforts to provide a quality Catholic education would not be possible. Thanks are also in order to those families of deceased loved ones who have designated Mater Dei as a memorial recipient, families who have established scholarships, and, of course, those people who have worked tirelessly "behind the scenes" for the betterment of Mater Dei Catholic High School.

As I reflect on the 2014-2015 school year, I realize what a wonderful story we have to share with the whole community. The hard work of both students and faculty has resulted in successes both in and out of the classroom. The mission of Mater Dei is being lived by our students and staff. Please be assured that our students are working hard to reach their goals and to prepare to become future leaders of their respective parishes and civic communities.

#### MISSION EFFECTIVENESS

Our Catholic faith and traditions are the heart and soul of Mater Dei. Our mission of fostering faith and developing gospel values makes us unique and is needed now more than ever. We are able to develop the mind and spirit in everything we do. Our daily Catholic environment, as well as our daily religious instruction and catholic teachings as they relate to the rest of the curriculum, includes the study of Church doctrine and traditions, the study of the liturgy, sacraments, scripture, morality, and social issues. There has been special emphases placed on the Corpel Works of Mercy, Social Justice and how we, as Catholics, are challenged to make a difference in our culture, society, and communities.

A key to our comprehensive program is to develop a sense of service and alms giving in all our students. Members of each class are expected to provide time in service of others. This program is capped off by the Senior Service project when our seniors work for three weeks in schools, hospitals, day care centers, shelters, and nursing homes. The Murray Center project continues to be a cornerstone of our student activities.

Along with Murray Center visits, Mater Dei students teach in local PSR classes, participate in the Big Brothers/Big Sisters program, adopt a mission and donate each week to that cause, hold food

drives, and coat drives, all for others! This past school year our students raised over \$10,000 through their weekly mission collection. This money was donated directly from the students during their homeroom period. Our young Vincentians (members of the Mater Dei chapter of the St. Vincent de Paul Society) organize and direct the student mission projects and special collections for local needs. Our Teens for Life Group continues to promote activities that highlight LIFE! Activities include prayer services at the abortion clinic in Granite City, participating in the Pro-Life march at the county courthouse in Carlyle, and sending supporters to the Pro-Life March in Washington, D.C.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP**

The academic success of our students continues! Mater Dei inducted 51 new members into the National Honor Society, had 21 seniors named Illinois State Scholars, and averaged over 48% on the Honor Roll. A special congratulation goes to Elizabeth Medlin, a senior from Aviston, who was named a National Merit Commended Student. The academic success is no accident at Mater Dei. The Class of 2015 reported that 99% of the class was planning to continue its education in the fall, 1% was entering the Marine Corps, and 1% was working on the family farm. Mater Dei continues to set the bar when it comes to ACT testing in the state. The MD Class of 2014's average ACT score was 24.4, outscoring the state average by over three points! The atmosphere of our school is conducive to learning. The expectation of our students and their teachers is one of working hard and staying focused on the job at hand. Mater Dei continues to walk with her students and their parents through our Campus Ministry, Academic Advisement office, Parent Portal and Schoology, and our peer tutoring program. Members of the Class of 2015 were offered \$7,200,150 in scholarship money for their college education as a result of their high school experience and success. Our seniors are planning to attend 33 different schools across the country in the fall of 2015. Out of this group, Grace Chiarolanza, a senior from Aviston, was offered and accepted an appointment to the Air Force Academy. Miss Chiarolanza will be our third student in three years to receive an appointment to one of the military academies! She follows 2013 graduate Luke Foppe, who attends the Naval Academy, and 2014 graduate Grant Camillo, who is a West Point cadet.

#### CIRRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Mater Dei is currently in the fifth year of a five-year school improvement plan. This plan is part of the AdvancED accreditation process in which Mater Dei participated this past school year. A team of five educators from across the state spent two days reviewing our programs and seeking information from students,

faculty members, and stake holders from the community. I am happy to report that we received high ratings and have received the approval for another five-year accreditation from AdvancED. Over the past few years, our dual-credit classes, through cooperation with Kaskaskia College, have increased. Courses that are offered at Mater Dei for dual credit include English 101 and 102, Speech 103, Accounting, Advanced Computer Applications, Chemistry Honors and Chemistry II, Cisco IA and Cisco IB, Physics Honors, Building Trades II, Small Business Management, and Weightlifting. Advance Placement exams are offered in Spanish, Calculus, and American History.

#### STUDENT ACTIVITIES

The year began with our award winning Marching Knights having a very successful season. The band, under the direction of Mr. Blake Korte, took its show on the road at O'Fallon High School, Eastern Illinois University, Effingham High School, Newton High School, and the University of Illinois band competitions as well as many parades throughout the state. The fall athletic season was very successful with the 2014 Football Knights continuing its winning ways and once again qualifying for the 4A play-offs. Coach Chad Rakers and the volleyball Lady Knights finished third in the 3A state volleyball tournament. Our boys' soccer team won the regional and went on to finish second in the sectional. The Lady Knights basketball team provided much entertainment as they finished second in the Highland Tournament. Our boys' basketball team qualified for the state tournament, coming home with a fourth place finish and capturing the hearts of the entire Mater Dei Community. The varsity cheerleading squad advanced to the ICCA State Competition. The girls' soccer team won its third regional and advanced to the Columbia Sectional. The girls' softball team also won the regional and competed well in the 3A softball sectional in Mascoutah. Mater Dei's Megan Deimeke qualified for the state track meet in May, competing in the shot put.

The Scholar Knights experienced success through Mr. Scott Timmermann's leadership. This group won the Clinton County Championship, the Catholic School Championship, and the IHSA regional. The Theater Department brought to the Mater Dei stage Agatha Christie's *Witness for the Prosecution* in the fall and the Disney classic *Tarzan* for its spring musical production.

#### **FINANCES**

Mater Dei has seen eighteen straight years of balanced budgets! These budgets have been the result of good planning, fiscal discipline, consistent enrollment, and commitments from both our local parishes and our alumni and friends. Please know how thankful we are at Mater Dei for all the support we receive throughout the school year. Our Calendar Drive

continues to lead the way with over 4,800 sales, along with the annual fund drive, Knight Club program, and golf tournament.

The support Mater Dei receives from the local parishes is outstanding. It is important that everyone understands that Mater Dei is his or her local Catholic high school, a very important part of the parish. As time moves on, the challenges Mater Dei will face will continue; however, with the support of these groups Mater Dei can sustain itself as the best buy in education in the area! Tuition for the 2014-2015 school year was \$4,861. With the sustained support of the entire Mater Dei Community we can continue to offer the best possible Catholic education at an affordable price. Thank you to all who have committed resources, financial and otherwise, to Mater Dei.

#### **CHALLENGES**

As we enter the 2015-2016 school year, we look forward to taking on the challenges that lie ahead. Our greatest challenge is always keeping control of our costs while we continue to enhance and expand the opportunities for all our students. Currently we are faced with replacing or rebuilding our boiler system, staying ahead with air conditioners in the classrooms, and dealing with constant concerns of a 55-year-old building.

Another issue facing our school community includes strengthening our Catholic identity within our community. Throughout this school year we will be looking at ourselves as a school community of faith and preparing for our Strategic Planning Retreat which will be held in the spring of 2016. Through this process, we will be developing our Strategic Plan for the next five years. Please know that if you are interested in serving on any of these committees you are most welcome to join us. Please contact me and I will be more than happy to assign you to a committee.

I hope you have found this letter to be interesting and informative. I am always excited to tell our story, a story that many of you have helped write. Mater Dei is a great place. It is not a perfect place, and the real joy about being part of the school is knowing the difference between the two. It is in fact this difference that moves all of us to come each day with the intention of being a better person and doing a better job whether a cafeteria worker, a student, a custodian, a teacher, or the Principal. Education is about the future. Catholic education is about the future in faith, and it is with that future in mind that I look forward to the 2015-2016 school year.






