Mater Dei Catholic High School is proud if its success in educating, fostering faith, and developing gospel values in the young men and women we have served since 1954. It also recognizes that in order to continue this success the need to evolve and improve is imperative.

With that in mind, members of Mater Dei's school board, administration, and faculty, along with alumni, parents, and pastors, were invited to participate in

the formation of committees to research, construct, and recommend strategies and goals for a school improvement plan. Committees addressed the school's Catholic identity, staffing, governance, finances, enrollment management, advancement, facilities, and curriculum. After months of gathering information, the committees came together on Saturday, March 12, for a Strategic Planning Retreat. Out of the discussions that day, strategic goals and plans of action were identified and formed the school improvement plan for the next five years. Strategic plans identified are:

Catholic Identity - (1) Create and maintain an undeniably Catholic learning experience in every aspect of our school. (2) Enhance our relationship with our parishes and the entire diocesan community. Governance - (1) Strengthen the role of the school board in its relationship to Mater Dei Catholic High School. (2) On-going review of current governance structure for Mater Dei Catholic High School. Curriculum and Learning – (1) Provide the faculty increased opportunities for collaboration and curriculum development. (2) Increase the use of technology in the classroom in order to enhance STEM education. (3) Hire a teacher to work with special needs students and provide professional development to Mater Dei teachers in differential instruction.

Enrollment Management —(1) Increase the number of students we currently serve as well as increase our percentage of students from our local communities. (2) Create opportunities to strengthen our retention and expand our International student population.

**Finances** – (1) Provide financial stability through sound financial practices. (2) Strengthen the partnership with our parish communities. (3) Increase the Student Assistance program.

**Staffing** – (1) Develop a plan to recruit/interview exceptional faculty, staff, and administration. (2) Review current staffing structure and modify/adjust to needs of the future.

Advancement – (1) Increase the annual fund in both number of donors and money received. (2) Work with the Foundation to enhance the Planned Giving program. (3) Broaden the scholarship and memorial grant program at Mater Dei Catholic High School.

(4) Enhance our public relations program.

**Facilities** – (1) Improve the "curb appeal" of the school facility. (2) Upgrade the academic wings of the school building and identify space to be renovated for a new purpose.

(3) Research the possibility of a new Fine Arts building.

(4) Research the feasibility of upgrading our chapel.

Details and timelines for strategy implementation are being developed.

As I reflect on the 2015-2016 school year, I realize what a wonderful story we have to share with the whole community. The hard work of both students and faculty has resulted in successes both in and out of the classroom. The mission of Mater Dei is being lived by our students and staff. Please be assured that our students are working hard to reach their goals and to prepare themselves to become future leaders of their respective church and civic communities

#### **MISSION EFFECTIVENESS**

Our Catholic faith and traditions are the heart and soul of Mater Dei. Our mission of fostering faith and developing gospel values makes us unique and is needed now more than ever. We are able to develop the mind and spirit in everything we do. Our daily Catholic environment as well as our daily religious instruction and catholic teaching, as they relate to the rest of the curriculum, includes the study of Church doctrine and traditions, the study of the liturgy, sacraments, scripture, morality, and social issues. There has been special emphasis placed on the Corpel Works of Mercy, Social Justice, and how we, as Catholics, are challenged to make a difference in our culture, society, and communities.

A key to our comprehensive program is to develop a sense of service and alms giving in all our students. Members of each class are expected to provide a part of their time to others through service. This program is capped off by the Senior Service project when our seniors work for three weeks in schools, hospitals, day care centers, shelters, and nursing homes. The Murray Center project continues to be a cornerstone of our student activities.

Along with Murray Center visits, Mater Dei students teach in the local PSR classes, participate in the Big Brother/Big Sister program, adopt a mission and donate each week to that cause, hold food drives, and take up special collections, all for others!

This past school year our students raised over \$10,000 through the weekly mission collection. This money was donated directly from the students during their homeroom period! Through our very own St. Vincent DePaul Society our students organize and direct the student mission projects and special collections for local needs. Our Teens for Life Group continues to promote activities which highlight LIFE! Activities include prayer services at the abortion clinic in Granite City, the Pro-Life March at the county courthouse in Carlyle, and the Pro-Life March in Washington, D.C.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP**

The academic success of our students continues! Mater Dei inducted 55 new members into the National Honor Society, had 28 seniors named Illinois State Scholars, and averaged over 48% on the Honor Roll. A special congratulation goes to Lindsay McCray, a senior from St. Rose, who was named a National Merit Finalist. The Class of 2016 also included two National Merit Commended students. Those students were Sam Krebs and Raymond Moylan, both from St. Dominic Parish in Breese. The academic success is no accident at Mater Dei. Of the 112 seniors in the Class of 2016, 99% reported that they were planning to continue their education in the fall, with one student working on the family farm. Mater Dei continues to set the bar when it comes to the ACT testing in the state. The Class of 2016 average ACT test score was 24.4, outscoring the state average by over 3.5 points! Quintin Potthast, son of Dan and Sue Potthast, scored a perfect 36 on the ACT exam! Potthast will be a freshman at the University of Illinois this fall.

The atmosphere of our school is conducive to learning. The expectation of our students and their teachers is also one of working hard and staying focused on the job at hand. Mater Dei continues to walk with each student and his or her parents through our Campus Ministry, Academic Advisement office, Parent Portal and Schoology, and our Peer Tutoring program. New in 2015-2016 was our Academic Integrity Program, a comprehensive approach to academic integrity which has been introduced to our entire school community. Members of the MD Class of 2016 were offered over \$10,000,000 in scholarship money for their college education as a result of their high school experience. Our seniors are planning to attend 39 different schools across the country in the fall of 2016. Out of this group, Sam Krebs, son of Brent and Amy Krebs, was offered and accepted an appointment to the Air Force Academy. Krebs will be our fourth student in as many years to receive an appointment to one of our nation's military academies!

#### **CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT**

Throughout the 2015-2016 school year, Mater Dei participated in the re-certification program through the State of Illinois and the Diocese of Belleville. A team of five educators from Southern Illinois spent a day reviewing our programming and seeking information from students, faculty members, and stake holders from the community. I am happy to report that

we received high ratings and have received notice that we will be re-accredited for another five years from the State Board of Education and the Diocese of Belleville.

Our dual credit opportunities continue to be very popular and beneficial to our students, saving thousands of dollars in college tuition for their families. Courses which are offered at Mater Dei for dual credit include English 101 and 102, Speech 103, Psychology, Sociology, Accounting, Advanced Computer Applications, Chemistry Honors and Chemistry II, Cisco IA and Cisco IB, Physics Honors, Building Trades II, Small Business Management, and Weightlifting and Conditioning. Advance Placement exams are also offered in Spanish, Calculus, and American History.

#### STUDENT ACTIVITES

The year began with our award winning Marching Knights having a very successful season. The band, under the direction of Mr. Blake Korte, competed in the O'Fallon High School, Eastern Illinois University, Effingham, Newton, and the University of Illinois Band Competitions, as well as many parades throughout the state. This year's field show entitled "Disappear" included diverse musical selections.

The Scholar Knights broke the record books by finishing third in the Class 2A State Scholar Bowl Tournament! This was the first year a Mater Dei team advanced past the sectional. Congratulations to Coach Scott Timmermann and his entire squad. This group won the Clinton County Championship and Catholic School Championship before they finished the season with the 2A IHSA third place trophy!

The fall athletic season was very successful with the 2015 Football Knights continuing its winning ways as the team finished its season in the Final Four of the 4A playoffs. Coach Chad Rakers and his volleyball Lady Knights rallied and won the Class 4A regional championship. Our boys' soccer team won the regional and went on to finish second in the sectional. The Lady Knights basketball team also won a regional championship, as it competed on a very competitive front throughout the season. Our boys' basketball team, competing in class 3A, continued to capture the hearts of the entire Mater Dei Community, as it won the Battle of Breese with a very exciting last second shot by senior Nick Pollmann. Our varsity cheerleading squad advanced to the ICCA State Competition. The girls' soccer team won its fourth regional and advanced to the 2A sectional. The girls' softball team was very young and showed much promise for the future throughout its season. Mater Dei qualified three individuals for the boys' and girls' state track meets. Luke Goebel qualified in the 3200 Open race, Megan Deimeke qualified in the shot put, and Taylor Padak qualified in the high jump.

The Theater Department brought to the Mater Dei stage "Father of the Bride" in the fall as well as the outstanding spring musical production of "Mary Poppins."

#### **FINANCES**

Mater Dei has been blessed over the past twenty years to be financially sound because of good planning, fiscal discipline, consistent enrollment, and commitments from our local parishes and our alumni and friends. Please know how thankful we are at Mater Dei for all the support we received throughout the past few school years in regards to our capital campaign! Our goal was reached because of YOUR commitment to Catholic education. Our Calendar Drive, Annual Fund Drive, Knight Club Program, and Golf Tournament continue to headline our special events income sources and are well supported by the Mater Dei community. We must also extend a huge thank you to our auxiliary groups, namely the Mothers and Friends, Fathers and Friends, and Band Parents, for all they do to help our financial situation!

The support Mater Dei receives from the local parishes is outstanding! It is important that members of these parishes understand that Mater Dei is THEIR local Catholic high school, a very important part of their parish. As time moves on, the challenges Mater Dei will face will continue; however, with the support of these groups Mater Dei can sustain itself in our area as the best buy in education. Our tuition for the 2015-2016 school year was \$4,961 for which we thank everyone who provided support, allowing us to offer the best possible Catholic education at this affordable price.

#### **CHALLENGES**

As we enter the 2016-2017 school year, we look forward to taking on our challenges that lie ahead. Our greatest challenge is always controlling our costs while continuing to enhance and expand our school and opportunities for all of our students. We are currently faced with replacing the sidewalks around the building and interior hallway and classroom doors, updating our restrooms and library, dealing with repairs of a 55 year-old building, and strengthening our Catholic Identity within our community. Throughout this school year we will be looking at ourselves, as a school community of faith, and preparing to implement our Strategic Plan, which was approved by our school board at the June 2016 meeting. Through this process we will be preparing our school for the next five to ten years!

I hope you have found this letter to be interesting and informative. I am always excited to tell our story, a story that many of you have helped write. Mater Dei is a great place. It is not a perfect place, and the real joy is knowing the difference between the two. It is in fact this difference that moves all of us to come each day with the intention of being a better person and doing a better job whether a cafeteria worker, a student, a custodian, a teacher, or the Principal. Education is about the future. Catholic education is about the future in faith, and it is with that future in mind that I look forward to the 2016-2017 school year.
