Throughout Mater Dei's 64-year existence, alumni, parents, parishes, and friends have stepped up to support this school through donations, time, talent, prayers, and loyalty because they know that our mission to educate, foster faith, and develop gospel values, which was envisioned for the new Catholic high school in 1954, is as important today as it has been throughout the past six-plus decades.

One of the favorite cheers at Mater Dei is "We are M.D." That statement may be uttered by ALL of you, as it is the people that have shaped and supported this institution. That being said, I would like to take this time to recognize the 60th Anniversary of the opening of the physical building that is Mater Dei Catholic High School. The new building was opened for "business" to start the 1958-1959 school year. Since that time, the original building grew with the addition of the gymnasium in 1961, the 5th wing in 1964, the reconstruction of the administrative offices and chapel in 1993, the new band room and auxiliary gym in 2004, the Lampe Commons (new student center) in 2013, the multi-purpose outdoor facility in 2014, and the overhaul of the school library into the Becker Learning Center in 2017. Along the way, upgrades and improvements have been made that have kept the building viable and up-to-date, with an emphasis on technological improvements in the last decade.

All of the efforts to improve the educational experience for our students, families, alumni, and friends depend on your support. As we move into the new school year, I am reminded of the blessing that is Mater Dei Catholic High School and Catholic education, and that we are all in this together!

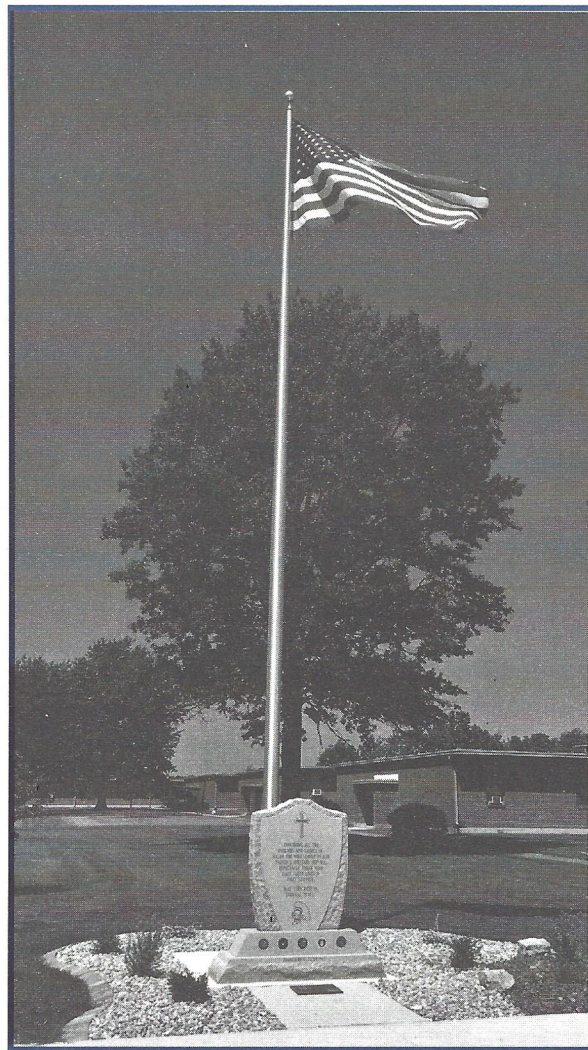

After recognizing that their class gift truly made a difference for Mater Dei, members of the Class of 1963 decided that funds left over from the monument project and subsequent donations by 1963 class members would be used to create and fund a new scholarship at Mater Dei. Representatives of the class who researched the scholarship became aware that most all of the scholarships offered at Mater Dei were for families of incoming freshmen. Therefore, they decided that the \$500/year Class of 1963 Scholarship would be awarded to a returning sophomore, junior, or senior that meets the criteria as long as the scholarship is funded.

In 1954, a new tradition began in the Clinton County area when St. Mary High School in Carlyle and St. Dominic High School in Breese were merged to form Mater Dei Catholic High School. Then in the fall of 1958, sixty years ago, the doors of the new school building were opened and the tradition of educating young people in a faith-based, service oriented program was initiated.

As Director of Advancement at Mater Dei, I would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you who have given so generously to the 2017-2018 Annual Fund Drive. Our theme for the annual fund drive these past several years has been: "Providing for Today and Securing for the Future." Indeed, your outstanding financial commitment has allowed you to help Mater Dei continue to provide a "comprehensive program to educate, foster faith, and develop gospel values" in the students we are privileged to serve.

As we prepare for the 2018-2019 Annual Fund Drive, we are continuing this theme for our annual drive. It is a way for our benefactors, and especially our alumni, to realize just how important they are to the continued successful operation of the educational program at Mater Dei, both for current needs and future development. For three generations, Mater Dei has provided a caring environment in which students have been challenged to experience God in themselves and in others through a cultivation of respect and a commitment to service. It has been said, "A generous person is enriched through the act of giving." Even through difficult and challenging economic times, you, our benefactors, have recognized the significant difference your generosity does and can make to enhance the educational program and progress of Mater Dei, and through your giving, both you and Mater Dei are blessed. For the 2018-2019 Annual Fund Drive we are going to continue our emphasis on "Major Gifts" and "Planned Giving" as ways in which we can continue to build upon the tradition of the past by securing a solid foundation for the future.

Major gifts help to grow the annual fund drive faster. A contribution of \$250.00 or more is considered a major gift. This year's annual report lists the contributors and an asterisk in front of a donor's name indicates that that person made a major gift to the fund drive. A major gift can also be attained through the benefit of a matching gift from your business or corporation. One can make a major gift by contributing \$125.00 and having a matching gift of \$125.00. Major gifts are important because they imply an individual's deeper interest and willingness to be part of the tradition of providing quality faith-based education.

The process of making a major gift for as little as \$250.00 can be simplified by making monthly or quarterly donations either through our on-line giving availability or by setting up payroll deductions. Your specified amount will be automatically deducted and then deposited directly to Mater Dei. These can easily be coordinated with your business or corporation or easily done on-line at the Mater Dei website with your initial donation and indicating it to be a recurring donation. And don't forget to check with your Human Resources department to see if your donation to Mater Dei will qualify for a matching gift. Four years ago we initiated a special Mass to recognize our Major Gift contributors and again this year we will be holding a Mass on Tuesday, September 18, in the Lampe Commons at 7:00pm, followed by a reception and time of fellowship and gratitude.

The techniques of Charitable Gift Planning include both revocable and irrevocable arrangements, gifts available for use at the time they are given, gifts that may not be available until a future date, and split-interest gifts intended to balance financial, personal, and charitable objectives. These techniques are called planned gifts.

Planned gifts, deferred gifts, and estate gifts are different names for a way to manage your affairs, plan for the future, and make a gift to Mater Dei Catholic High School. Planned gifts are a variety of charitable giving methods that allow you to express your personal values by integrating your charitable, family, and financial goals. Making a planned charitable gift usually requires the assistance of a knowledgeable advisor such as an attorney, financial planner, or CPA to help structure the gift. Donors should seek charitable gift planning advice from professionals with integrity, expertise, and experience in law, investments, property, tax, and charitable transfers in order to assure both the technical merits of the transfer and the philanthropic quality of the gift. George Kruse, our Advancement Office Planned Giving adviser, can also be of great assistance in setting up these gifts, which can benefit both you and Mater Dei Catholic High School.

Planned gifts can be made with cash, but many planned gifts are made by donating assets such as IRA's, life insurance, annuities, stocks, real estate, art pieces, or business interests. The possibilities are endless, considering all types of real and personal property and tangible and intangible assets. Planned gifts can provide valuable tax benefits and/or lifetime income for you and your spouse or other loved one. The most frequently made planned gifts are bequests to charities, made through your will. Other popular planned gifts include charitable trusts.

### Why Should I make a Planned Gift?

Many people want to make charitable gifts but need to do so in a way that helps meet their other personal, family, or financial needs. Planned gifts give you options for making your charitable gifts in ways that may allow you to:

- Make a larger charitable gift than you thought possible
- Increase your current income
- Plan for the financial needs of a spouse or loved one
- Provide inheritances for your heirs at a reduced tax cost
- Reduce your income tax and/or avoid capital gains tax
- Diversify your investment portfolio
- Receive income from your personal residence or farm
- Plan for the transfer of your business
- Leave a charitable legacy for future generations

Where there is a WILL, there is a way to continue to make a difference in partnering with us in the mission of educating our students when you take but a little time to investigate the possibilities.

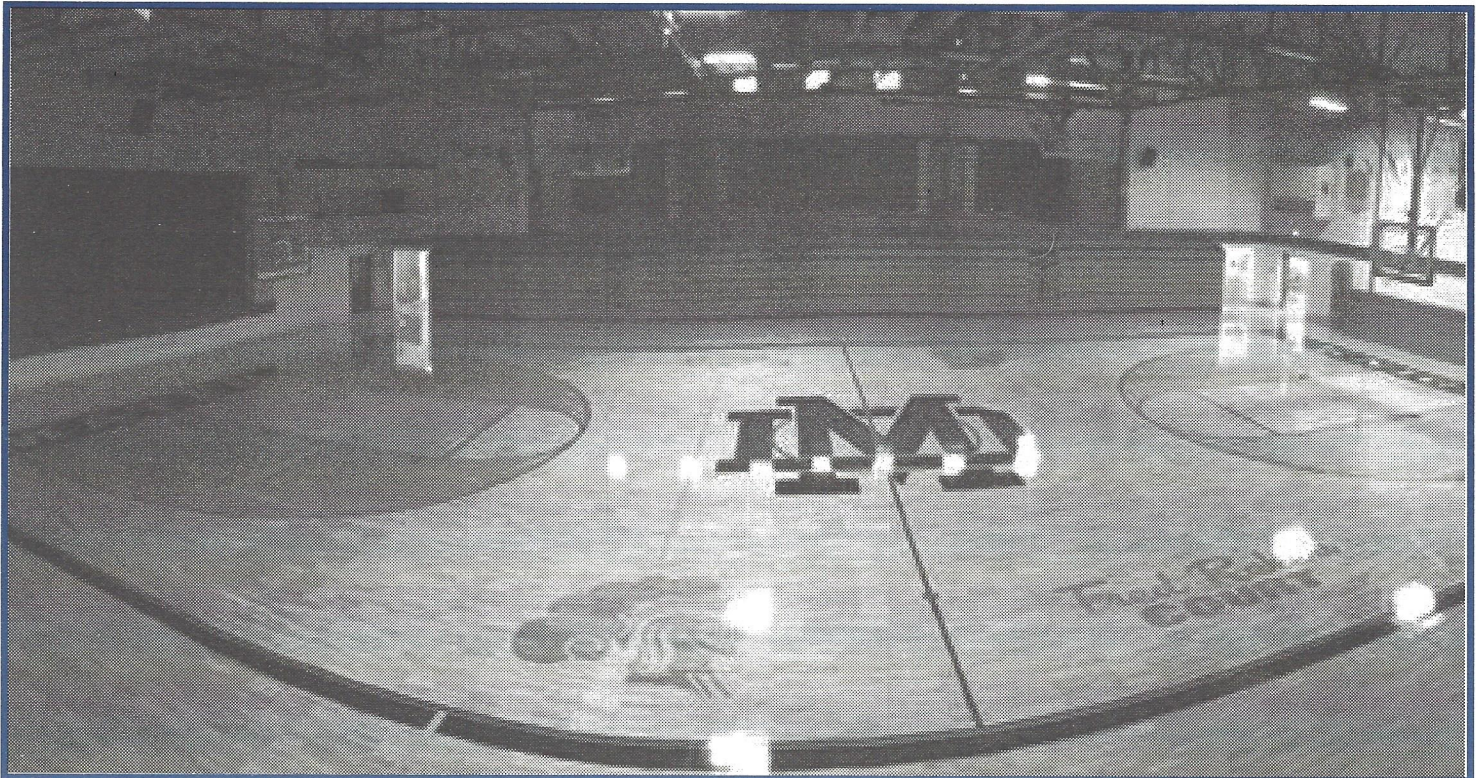
