

Giving Tuesday is celebrated on the Tuesday following Thanksgiving (in the U.S.) and the widely recognized shopping events of Black Friday and Cyber Monday. It kicks off the charitable season, when many focus on their holiday and end-of-year giving. Since its beginning in 2012, Giving Tuesday has become a movement that celebrates and supports giving and philanthropy, a day dedicated to service and giving back. The day is meant to harness the potential of social media and enlist the generosity of individuals who wish to make a financial contribution to a charity that they hold close to their hearts.

Last year Mater Dei Catholic High School participated for the third time through our online giving portal. In our third attempt we raised \$1,180.00 from 13 donors. Our efforts this year will be to get the word out sooner and wider. You will have the opportunity to donate on that day particularly (or any day) at either of our websites: www.materdeiknights.org or www.materdeialumni.org and click the "Donate" button. You will also have the opportunity to choose which of the four funds (or a combination of them) you would like to direct your contribution.

Remember, your gift to Mater Dei Catholic High School goes a long way to help in our mission to provide an excellent Catholic secondary education that is affordable, available, and accessible to every student who desires to attend Mater Dei. The cost to educate a student at Mater Dei this year is \$8,852.00, of which the tuition covers only \$5,686.00. Our fundraising efforts per student is \$1,662.00. We rely upon the generous support and contributions from individuals like you, who recognize the priceless treasure Mater Dei has become.

As we look forward to December 3, keep in mind the beautiful motto: "A generous person is enriched through the act of giving."

ILLINOIS TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship Program was designed for you to both support Catholic Education and at the same time reduce your Illinois tax liability. For example, if you have an estimated 2019 Illinois tax due of \$750.00 and you make a \$1,000.00 donation to Mater Dei Catholic High School, through the Illinois Tax credit scholarship program, called Empower Illinois, you will receive a \$750.00 Illinois tax credit for 2019, literally making your out of pocket donation only \$250.00 (since the \$750.00 you already owed the State of Illinois will now be used to benefit Mater Dei Catholic High School). In other words, up to 75% of what you donate will be an Illinois tax credit to you.

A full explanation of how to enroll and make your donation was included in the 2018-2019 Annual Report that you recently received and a digital copy of the report can be found on the Mater Dei website (materdeiknights.org). On the website, go to the Advancement tab, then click on the dropdown titled Annual Fund Drive, then, under the Annual Report paragraph, click on 2018-2019 Mater Dei Catholic High School Annual Report.




TWO MD SENIORS EARN NATIONAL MERIT RECOGNITION

For the past 34 years, Mater Dei has run a very successful fundraiser: the Calendar Drive. Last year, 4,551 calendars were sold that netted a profit that allowed the 2019-2020 tuition to be \$200 per student less than it would have been without this fundraiser. All profits from the calendar drive go back to the students to reduce the tuition increase for the next school year. Therefore, each student is asked to sell at least eight calendars and, if he/she attains this quota, will receive April 17, 2020, off from school. Students are also allowed to wear jeans or sweatpants on Fridays throughout the calendar drive (through January 31, 2020) upon selling their eight calendars. Students who sell ten or more calendars are also eligible to receive cash prizes based on the number of calendars they sell in multiples of 5, plus they are given special costume days to dress up with a particular theme throughout the drive and into 2020. Top sellers in each of the freshman, sophomore, and junior classes are awarded tuition grants of \$500 (for highest sales in their class) and \$200 (for second highest sales in their class). Top senior sellers are competing for prizes of \$500 (top seller), \$250 (second place seller), and \$150 (third place seller).

Each day there is a \$30.00 winner drawn plus on the last day of the month there are two additional drawings for \$100 and \$500. And, on the last day of the year, there are two further additional grand prize drawings for \$1,000 and \$2,000. After each drawing, your name is put back into the pot for a chance to win again.

Calendars can be obtained from any Mater Dei student for \$25.00 each. You can also use the form at the top of this page or go online to the Mater Dei website (materdeiknights.org) and purchase your 2020 Mater Dei Calendar there. You can designate a student to receive credit for the sale. We appreciate all who have contributed to the success of this fundraiser throughout the years!
