Dear Friends of Mater Dei,



AUCTION RULES

SILENT AUCTION

- Silent Auction bidding will begin at 5:00 p.m. on the day of the auction.
- The bidding starts with a minimum bid and subsequent bids must follow the minimum raise or a larger amount in the bid increments. The highest bidder wins.
- Silent Auction bidding will close approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the Oral Auction.
- All successful bidders must pay for items that evening. Winners may pick up their items in the Silent Auction area.
- Please do not remove items from the auction tables. Volunteers will retrieve the items for you.

ORAL AUCTION

- Oral Auction will begin at 8:15 p.m.
- An Oral Auction bid is entered by raising your bid number and being recognized by the auctioneer.
- The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the purchaser. In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer will have the sole and final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer and resell the item in dispute.
- Once an item has been sold, an auction spotter will bring a copy of the bid sheet to the purchaser to sign to acknowledge receipt of the item and acceptance of the stated price.
- The auctioneer has the right to determine the increments on each item. The auctioneer has the final authority to determine the successful bidder or to resell and re-offer the item. 
