KASKASKIA COLLEGE JUMP START PROGRAM an opportunity to earn college credit with reduced tuition

Current freshmen, sophomores, and juniors — who are all eligible to participate in the Kaskaskia College Jump Start Program — still have time to register for a summer semester course!

The Jump Start Program provides students who will be sophomores, juniors, or seniors during the 2024-2025 school year with the opportunity to enroll in <u>one course</u> (maximum three credit hours) each semester for <u>half the cost of tuition and mandatory fees</u>. Students are also responsible for the full cost of course fees, textbooks, and lab fees (if applicable.)

NOTE: These courses are <u>not</u> dual credit courses. Credit is earned <u>only</u> at Kaskaskia College (<u>not</u> at Mater Dei.) Thus, we recommend enrolling in courses that are <u>not</u> offered as dual credit courses at Mater Dei.

SENIORS: REQUEST TRANSCRIPTS VIA PARCHMENT Mater Dei transcripts and Kaskaskia College transcripts

Seniors must order transcripts for Mater Dei and Kaskaskia College (for dual credit courses) via their Parchment account (www.parchment.com).

In their account, students must add Mater Dei and Kaskaskia College as institutions. (The Kaskaskia College student ID will be required.) They may then place an order at any time and should indicate "hold for grades."

NOTES

In order for Mater Dei to receive ACT scores, the registration must include our CEEB code (where a student attends school). The Mater Dei CEEB code is 140-395.

Test accommodations must be requested at the time of registration. International and ELL students are eligible for extended time.

To avoid extra fees in the future, at the time of registration, students should list potential college choices to which they would like their ACT scores to be sent.
