The Mater Dei boys and girls soccer camp is designed to develop age-appropriate skills: for pre-kindergarten (age 4) through grade 3, fundamental ball handling skills and light conditioning drills; for grades 4 and 5, advanced ball handling skills, fundamental game tactics, and light conditioning drills; for grades 6, 7 and 8, advanced ball handling skills, game tactics, and conditioning drills.
